



**SECTION 2.** Section 2 of Municipal Ordinance No. 12 Series 2005 is hereby amended to be read into:

**"Section 2. The use, management and disposition of the Per Family Payment Rate shall be governed by the following rules:**

**1. The PFPR amount shall be released on a quarterly basis by the Corporation under the following rules:**

**1.1 The release of the PFPR amount shall be subject to accreditation of the municipal-owned and managed Rural Health Unit and the payment of contribution by the sponsoring agency and the qualified groups.**

**1.2 The release of quarterly PFPR shall be subject to the submission of required Monitoring and evaluation reports, research and program development as provided under the Implementing Guidelines of the Primary Care benefit 1 and prior payment premiums.**

**2. The disposition of the PFPR shall be governed by the following rules:**

**2.1 The disbursement and liquidation of the PFPR shall be in accordance with pertinent government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;**

**2.2 A separate book of accounts shall be maintained by the Local Government Unit.**

**2.3 Eighty percent (80%) of the PFPR is for operational cost and shall be divided as follows:**

**2.3.1 Minimum of forty percent (40%) for drugs and medicines listed in the Philippine National Drug Formulary (to be dispensed at the facility) including drugs and medicines needed for Asthma, Acute Gastroenteritis and Pneumonia; and**

**2.3.2 Maximum of forty percent (40%) for laboratory reagents, medical supplies, equipments (ie., ambulance, ambubag, stretcher, etc) information technology (IT equipments specific for facility use needed to facilitate reporting and database buildup), capacity building for staff, infrastructure or any other use related and necessary for the delivery of required service including referral fees or diagnostic services if not available in the facility.**

**2.3.3 The remaining twenty percent(20%) shall be exclusively utilized as honoraria of the staff of the PCB1 facility and for the improvement of their capabilities as would enable them to provide better health services:**

- a. Ten percent (10%) for the physician;**
- b. Five percent (5%) for other health professional staff of the facility; and**
- c. Five percent (5%) for non-health professional staff, including volunteers."**

**SECTION 3.** The title is likewise amended to conform with Philhealth Circular No. 10 Series of 2012 to be read into:

### MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-03

#### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 12 SERIES OF 2005 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE SETTING-UP THE PHIL HEALTH CAPITATION FUND, THE RULES THAT GOVERN THE DISPOSITION OF THE FUND AND THE OPENING DEPOSITORY ACCOUNT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES SOLELY FOR THE FUND."**

WHEREAS, Sec. 2(a) RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local government Code of 1991 declared the policy of the state that territorial and political subdivisions of the state shall enjoy genuine and meaningful autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and more effective partners in the attainment of national goals;

WHEREAS, the state also declares that the vesting of duty, responsibility and accountability in Local Government Units shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to discharge their powers and effectively carry out their functions;

WHEREAS, the Rural Health Center of Nueva Era, Ilocos Norte has been accredited by Philhealth as a Health Care Provider under the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package of the Medicare sa Masa Program;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 1587 Series 2012 of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation amended the implementation of the Outpatient Benefit Package and approved a Primary Care Benefit I (PCBI) Package;

WHEREAS, the implementing guidelines for Universal Health Care Primary Care I PCBI Package for Transition Period CY 2012-2013 was issued under Philippine Health Insurance Corporation Circular No. 10 Series of 2012.

WHEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Nueva Era that:

#### **SECTION 1. Section 1 of Municipal Ordinance No. 12 Series 2005 is hereby amended to be read into:**

"**Section 1. There is hereby created a PhilHealth Per Family Payment Rate (PFPR) from the proceeds of the Primary Care Benefit I to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation to cover the members under the LGU-sponsored Program (e.g. Indigent Families, Barangay Health Works, Barangay Nutrition Scholars, Barangay Service Point Officers, Barangay Tanod) Organized Groups and Overseas Workers Program and their qualified members of the Municipality of Nueva Era.**"

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 15  
SERIES OF 2002 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE SETTING-UP THE PHIL  
HEALTH CAPITATION FUND", THE RULES THAT GOVERN THE DISPOSITION OF THE FUNDS  
AND THE OPENING DEPOSITORY ACCOUNT WITH THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE  
PHILIPPINES FOR THE FUND".

WHEREAS, sec. 5(a) RA 7460 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991  
declared the policy of the state that local government and local government units shall enjoy  
separate and independent authority to manage their internal development as self-  
governing communities and more effective partners in the attainment of national goals;

WHEREAS, the state also decides that the vesting of duty, responsibility and  
accountability in Local Government Units shall be accompanied with proportionate  
adequate resources to discharge their powers and effectiveness clearly and effectively;

WHEREAS, the Rural Health Center of Nueva Era, Ilocos Norte has been accredited by  
Philippines as a Health Care Provider under the Outpatient Consultation and Disbursement Package  
of the Magdicat sa Mass Program;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 1583 Series 2013 of the Philippine Health Insurance  
Commission amended the implementation of the Outpatient Benefit Package and approved a  
Philippines Care Benefit (PCB) package;

WHEREAS, the implementation guidelines for Universal Care Benefit Care (PCB)  
package for Treasury Bond CY 2013 was issued under the Philippine Health Insurance  
Commission Circular No. 10 Series of 2013.

WHEREFORE, being enacted by the Sanguniang Bayan of Nueva Era this:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Municipal Ordinance No. 15 Series 2002 is hereby amended to read

"Section 1. There is hereby created a Public Health Care Facility Payment Rate (PHPR) from  
the proceeds of the Primary Care Benefit I to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance  
Commission to cover the expenses under the LGU-subsidized program (e.g. Indigent Patients,  
Benevolent Hospital Works, Barangay Nutrition Scholars, Barangay Service Point Officers, Barangay  
Tambong) Disseminated Goods and Overlays Workshops and their affiliated members of the  
Municipality of Nueva Era".
