# MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 39 Series of 2021

AN ORDINANCE ON COLLECTION OF CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS RELATED TRANSACTIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NUEVA ERA, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, there is a need to streamline/simplify the process of business registration in the Municipality of Nueva Era to provide a more efficient and effective revenue collection and to promote a friendlier atmosphere for taxpayers and investors;

**WHEREAS**, when regulations are simple and transparent entrepreneurs need not to suffer from red tape and time consuming transactions;

**WHEREAS**, the EODB ACT of 2018 or Republic Act 11032, otherwise known as "an Act Promoting Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Delivery of Government Services was signed into law seeks to make the process of putting up and running a business in the Philippines easier and more efficient:

**WHEREAS,** Section 11 (f) of RA 11032 provides that "Barangay Clearances and permits related to doing business shall be applied, issued and collected at the Municipality in accordance with the prescribed processing time of said Act. Provided, that the share in the collections shall be remitted to the respective barangays;

WHEREAS, Barangays in the Municipality of Nueva Era, enacted Barangay Resolutions to authorize the Municipality of Nueva Era to issue barangay clearance and collect corresponding barangay clearance fee in the application for any business related transactions subject to the remittance of the aforesaid fees to the barangay and the conditions hereunder;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Nueva Era, Ilocos Norte, in a session duly assembled that :

**SECTION 1. COVERAGE.** This policy applies only to the issuance of Barangay Clearance for business permit and locational clearance (as a requirement for the issuance of building permit) at the Municipality. Other clearances for other purposes shall be still obtained in the barangay.

This circular shall cover the concerned Local Officials and Punong Barangays.







**SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** The words and phrases used in this ordinance are hereby defined as follows:

- a. Barangay Clearance refers to any and all documents issued by the barangays with or without corresponding fees as defined in their ordinances relative to or in relation to the issuance of business permit and locational/zoning clearance by the municipality or any other permit as required (IRR OF RA 11032)
- b. Barangay Clearance Fees an amount imposed by the barangays through an ordinance and collected by the municipality in relation to the issuance of business permit and locational clearance by the municipality.
- c. **Business Permit** is a document that must be secured from the municipal government usaually through its Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) for a business to legally operate in the locality. (IRR of RA 11032).
- d. Locational Clearance is a clearance issued by the Zoning Administrator/Officer to a project that is allowed under the provisions of an ordinance of a particular municipality. It is a requirement for the issuance of Building Permit (House and Land Use Regulatory Board-Comprehensive Land Use Plan Guidebook)

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY TO COLLECT BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE OF BUSINESS RELATED TRANSACTIONS – The Municipality of Nueva Era is given the authority to collect Barangay Clearance Fee subject to the remittance to the subject Barangay.

**SECTION 4. RATE OF BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE TO BE COLLECTED** – The rate of Barangay Clearance Fee to be collected by the Municipality for the issuance of clearance shall be computed in accordance with the subject Barangay Revenue Ordinance herein attached as "Annex A", and made as an integral part hereof.

**SECTION 5. BARANGAY CLEARANCE SIGNATORY** – Electronic Signature of Punong Barangay concern shall appear in all barangay clearance issued.

**SECTION 6. REPORTING AND REMITTANCE** – The Municipality shall remit the Barangay Clearance Fee collected to the subject Barangay not later than seven (7) working days of the ensuing month with the list of the issued Building and Business Permit.

SECTION 7.**SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If for any reason, a part of this Ordinance is declared invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE**. Any law, ordinance or executive order which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.



# THE HONORABLE PRESIDING OFFICER & MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN

RE: Municipal Ordinance No. 39 Series of 2021 of the Municipality of Nueva Era entitled "AN ORDINANCE ON COLLECTION OF CORRESPONDING BARANGAY CLEARANCE FEE IN THE APPLICATION FOR ANY BUSINESS RELATED TRANSACTIONS".

### FINDINGS AND OBSERVATIONS:

- 1. Municipal Ordinance No. 39 Series of 2021 enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Nueva Era provides for the collection of the corresponding barangay clearance fees for any business related transactions;
- 2. The legislative intent of the ordinance is to streamline the process of business registration or renewal, thereby providing a more efficient and effective revenue collection procedure;
- 3. It is pursuant to RA 11032 entitled "An Act Promoting Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Delivery of Government Services", Sec. 11, paragraph (f) thereof provides:
  - "(f) Barangay clearances and permits related to doing business shall be applied, issued, and collected at the city/municipality in accordance with the prescribed processing time of this Act: Provided, That the share in the collections shall be remitted to the respective barangays."
- 4. As such, the opinion of the Local Finance Committee of the Provincial Government of Ilocos Norte was sought, and came out with their findings, to quote:

That the ordinance is within the authority and power of the Municipality of Nueva Era as provided for under Section 129 of the Local Government Code of 1991 and also within the authority of the Sangguniang Bayan pursuant to Section 447.2 (ii) of the said
