**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-167
A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING STRONG SUPPORT TO THE PROPOSED PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE BILLS INTO LAW IN THE 19TH CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES**

WHEREAS, the proposed bills by the Philippine National Police were presented and discussed during the Municipal Multi-Council Meeting on September 25, 2023, as issues and concerns on the Peace and Order of the municipality.

WHEREAS, among the priority bills were the a) Granting of Educational Assistance to the dependents of Uniformed PNP Personnel who were unfortunately killed or permanently incapacitated while in the performance of their duty; b) Providing Magna Carta for the PNP; c) Increasing the Quota requirements of the PNP female officers; d) Amending educational requirements of PNP applicants; e) Free Legal Assistance to Military and Uniformed Personnel; and f) Strengthening Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment of PNP Uniformed Personnel;

WHEREAS, upon deliberation, it was considered that the proposed bills will strengthen and uplift the PNP's bestowed obligations for the benefit of the county and increase the morale of PNP personnel;

WHEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF NUEVA ERA, ILOCOS NORTE THAT . . .
